COVID-19 Symptoms & Testing

People with these symptoms or combination of symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Cough
- Shortness of Breath



Or a combination of at least two of the following symptoms:

- Fever, Chills,
 Shaking with Chills
- Headache
- Sore Throat
- Muscle Pain
- New Loss of Taste or Smell



Your healthcare provider will determine if you need to be tested for COVID-19.

Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus.

Emergency Warning Signs

If you experience any of these symptoms, seek medical attention immediately:

- Difficulty breathing
- Persistent chest pain or pressure
- New confusion or inability to arouse
- Bluish face or lips

*List is not all-inclusive, if you have a medical emergency, dial 911.

Notify the operator if you think you may have COVID-19.





At this time, there are currently no antiviral drugs approved by FDA to treat COVID-19.
