HOW LOUD IS TOO LOUD?

Sounds should be 85 dB or under

Can't find the dB level? Send a chat to the toymaker and ask for the dB level

Test the Toy Yourself! Download a decibel meter app

Shopping online? Check description for loudness (dB) level



WAYS TO TURN DOWN THAT SOUND

Look for toys that have volume control

Put tape, glue, or even a sticker over the speaker

Limit the time spent with sound generating toys

Teach and model safe listening
